Description

The Corsair 750 Dash MK II is a lightweight, exceptionally fast, well-natured toy without neglecting safety on board, which is of high importance at Corsair Marine. A real pocket cruiser with a sporty speed potential. In harbor, the Corsair impresses with her sophisticated folding mechanism for the floats, which makes narrow berths accessible. With her variable draft, the trimaran is also the ideal yacht for a trip to the shallow bays of the Danish islands. Exceptionally well-maintained and extensively equipped first-hand owner's yacht. In addition to the components installed on board, the seller has a large inventory of spare parts and additional sails. The offer also includes an Ohlmeier slip trailer. The Corsair 750 Dash MK II has only been sailed in the Baltic Sea.
