### Description

Sturdy, seaworthy cruiser built by the Swedish quality yard Hallberg-Rassy on the boatbuilder's island of Orust. The Hallberg-Rassy 372 is a fast, stiff sailing yacht that is easy to steer and safe to sail in all conditions. The deep cockpit with fixed windshield and high coaming offers good protection and wide, unobstructed running decks allow safe movement even in rough conditions. Ample storage space throughout the yacht in lockers, drawers and compartments. The quality of boatbuilding craftsmanship at the traditional Hallberg-Rassy shipyard on the island of Orust in the Swedish western archipelago sets standards: the GRP workmanship, the interior finish and the quality of technical installations are immaculate. The Hallberg-Rassy 372 was voted "European Yacht of the Year 2010". This Hallberg-Rassy 372 is a well-maintained and extensively equipped yacht offered by her first owner. Indoor winter storage every year and continuous technical service. Complete specification incl. furling mast, bow thruster, inverter, electric winches, extensive FURUNO navigation system incl. radar and AIS, electric toilet etc. The Hallberg-Rassy 372 is moored on the German coast of the Baltic Sea, can be viewed any time upon appointment and is available for immediate delivery.
