## Description

Sturdy and very seaworthy bluewater-cruiser from the drawing board of dutch designer Dick Koopmans. This Koopmans 47 has been built by a professional shipyard (Spiro Ships from Enkhuisen in the Netherlands). Solid construction in seawater-resistant aluminium and hull painting in AWLGrip (hull was repainted in 2000 at Wrede). The shaft drive, the hull shape with S-shaped bulkhead, the watertight collision bulkhead in the fore ship, the massive skeg in front of the rudder blade and the high ballast ratio (ballast: approx. 7,000 kg) make the Koopmans 47 a reliable, safe "heavy duty" yacht for long-distance cruising in uncomfortable conditions. Well protected, deep cockpit with high coaming, sprayhood and sprayhood attachment (converts to a doghouse in bad weather). Beautiful, massive and well finished interior in teak with frames and fiddles etc. in solid wood. 3 cabin layout with split saloon on two levels, forward owner's cabin, two aft cabins and two heads compartments. This Koopmans 47 was custom built for her first and only owner and has many modifications and special details. The yacht is equipped with a wind generator, wind steering system, a sprayhood that can be converted to a doghouse and a shortwave radio system. The cockpit layout is designed for one-handed sailing: All winches including the central mainsheet winch are accessible from the helm station. In beautiful interior she offers an amazing amount of comfort and storage space.

## Interior/Layout

- Spacious "split level" saloon with plenty of light and air through four hull windows, superstructure windows, three deck hatches and two Dorade-ventilators
- On the companionway to port there is a bathroom with separate shower
- On starboard there is a very seaworthy U-shaped galley
  - Work surface in white CORIAN
  - Gas stove FORCE 10 (3 flames/oven)
  - Electrical remote switch for gas valve
  - Fridge
  - ice box
  - Double sink with manual foot pump for seawater and fresh water
- The forward section of the saloon is two steps down
- U-shaped dinette at the saloon table on starboard side
- Chart table with rotating navigator's seat on port side and large bookcases
- Coffee table and single chair on port side forward
- Owner's cabin forward with double berth (with lee cloth sail) on starboard side Bench, dressing table, safe and plenty of storage space in cupboards, drawers, storage compartments, shelves and a large drawer for sea charts. Good ventilation through large deck hatch and two Dorade fans.
- Owner's bathroom in the forepeak
- From the forward head compartment, a watertight submarine door provides access to a large stowage in the forepeak
- Starboard aft cabin with double berth, wardrobe, storage compartments, two opening portholes and a cabintop window
- Port aft cabin with two single berths (with lee cloth sail), Cupboard, storage compartments, two opening portholes and a cabintop window
- solid body, lovingly finished teak interior in the best Dutch boatbuilding tradition
- The yacht offers an amazing amount of storage space in cupboards, drawers, storage compartments, under the floorboards, seats and berths. Every hollow space is used.

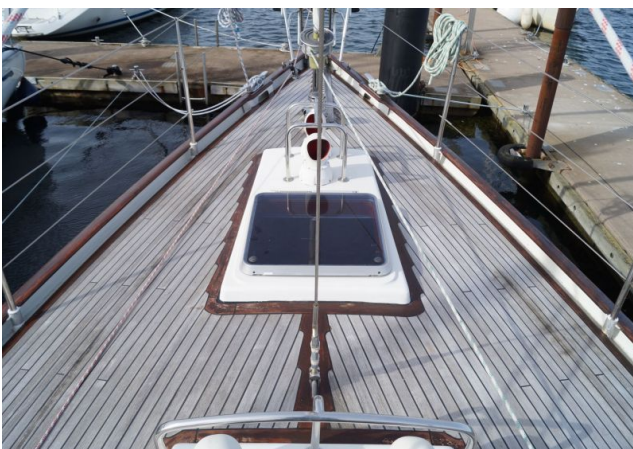
