Description

Fully equipped and well maintained center cockpit cruiser built by the quality yard Najadvarvet in the western swedish archipelago. The NAJAD 380 is an extremely safe and seaworthy cruising yacht for couples or families. Deep and protected center cockpit with fixed windscreen. Wide, unobstructed running decks with raised bulwark for safemovement on decks at any time. All sheets, halyards and trim lines are led back to the cockpit so the yacht can be maneuvered one handed. Exclusive, very well finished interior in mahogany in best Swedish boatbuilder's tradition. This NAJAD 380 is in many respects a custom-made yacht. More than 100.000 Euro were invested in extras and individual modifications. The enlarged owner's cabin, the separate shower cabin forward as well as additional storage compartments and lockers make this yacht a perfect, very comfortable cruiser. The current owner has spent a lot of money since 2015 on additional equipment and renovations (new sails, rebuilding the bottom paint, completely new canvases, etc.).
