Description

Seaworthy and very well maintained center cockpit cruiser built by Najadvarvet AB in Sweden. Modern design by judel/vrolijk [&] co. Deep, protected center cockpit with high coaming and fixed windscreen with lateral handrails. Wide running decks with raised coaming allow safe movement on deck. Single-handed cockpit layout with all sheets and trim lines led back to the winch consoles next to the helm (no coachhouse winches). Beautiful, well finished, satin varnished mahogany interior in the best Scandinavian boatbuilder's tradition. 2-cabin layout with owner's cabin aft across the entire beam of the yacht and large longitudinal galley with ample storage space in passage to aft cabin to port. A special features in the interior layout of this NAJAD 400 is the central island berth in the owner's cabin and the separate shower cabin forward to port. Upgraded YANMAR 75 hp diesel with shaft drive and flexible coupling (Aquadrive). The yacht has always been in indoor winter storage at the german NAJAD service center, where she had continuous care and technical maintenance. She is in mint condition. The bottom paint was completely rebuilt in 2019. Numerous investments since 2020. The NAJAD 400 can be viewed any time upon appointment and is available for immediate handover.

Layout/Interior

- Very well finished interior in satin varnished African mahogany with beautiful details and lots of solid wood in moldings, frames and profiles
- Floorboards in teak with light stripes
- Saloon with L-shaped dinette to port and longitudinal sofa to starboard at the folding saloon table
- Large forward facing chart table with navigator's seat to starboard aft
- Longitudinal galley in passage to aft cabin to port
 - Gas stove (2 burners and oven)
 - Electric remote switch for gas valve
 - Double sink
 - Large electric cool box
 - Ample storage space in lockers, drawers and compartments
- Owner's cabin aft over the entire beam of the yacht with island double berth (slatted frames below mattresses), seat, deck hatch, coachhouse windows, two portholes in transom and plenty of storage space in lockers, drawers and compartments below the berth

- Heads compartment to starboard with electric toilet and sink
- Separate shower cabin forward to port
- Forward cabin with V-shaped double berth and locker
- Blinds and mosquito screens in deck hatches
- Good ventilation thanks to four Dorade vents on deck, numerous opening coachhouse windows and large deck hatches
- Red night lights in interior
