#### Description

Seaworthy cruiser in easy to handle size built by Bootswerft Gerhard Bicker. The Biga 330 is the largest model of the quality shipyard in North Rhine-Westphalia. Elegant hull designed by Georg Nissen with classic lines and angular mahogany coachhouse. Despite her traditional appearance, the Biga 330 has very good sailing characteristics thanks to modern appedinxes and efficient rig. Although the Biga 330 is traditionally finished in mahogany, the saloon and cabins do not appear to be dark thanks to white painted woodwork and ceiling panelling as well as light-coloured upholstery. Both cabins offer a surprising amount of living space and comfort for a yacht of this size. This Biga 330 is a virtually new, hardly used owner's yacht (the engine has 12.7 operating hours). The yacht was launched for the first time in April 2021 and is now to be sold for personal reasons. Extensive specification incl. diesel heating, chart plotter, autopilot, VHF-radio etc. The yacht is located on the Schlei (Baltic Sea), can be viewed any time by appointment and is available for immediate delivery.

#### Construction

- Hull:
  - Solid hand laid laminate
  - White NPG Iso gelcoat
  - Decorative stripes embedded in gelcoat
  - Hull interior sealed with topcoat
  - Osmosis protection Gelshield on underwater hull
- Attachments:
  - Lead keel with cast-in stainless steel frame
  - 16 keel bolts M12
  - Balanced spade rudder
  - JEFA roller bearings top and bottom
  - Aluminium rudder shaft with welded ribs

- Deck:
  - Substructure of Ballweger, deck beams and slings glued and bolted together
  - 10 mm solid teak deck on 8 mm mahogany plywood glued and epoxy bonded
  - Foot rail in solid teak
  - Teak rubbing strake on hull sides
- Coachhouse:
  - Sides in 12 mm plywood with mahogany veneer
  - Epoxy primer and 8 coats of 2-component PU varnish
  - Cabin roof in 8 mm mahogany plywood with 10 mm solid teak deck

- Teak deck on running decks, coachhouse roof and in cockpit
- Stainless steel mooring cleats and spring cleats
- Solid stainless steel bow fitting with anchor bracket
- Mooring gear: FOB-anchor 14 kg with 10 m chain leader 8 mm and 30 m anchor line
- Cold moulded tiller with tiller extension and tiller lock
- Genoa winches ANDERSEN 40.2ST
- Coachhouse winches ANDERSEN 18ST

- Genoa tracks with line-adjustable sheeting points
- Sprayhood with stainless steel hoops
- Sprayhood extension
- Large aft and starboard cockpit lockers
- Swallow nests in cockpit coaming to starboard and port
- Removable teak cockpit table with dedicated storage in port cockpit locker
- Swim ladder
