### Description

Sturdy, well-equipped centercockpit yacht built by the Swedish quality yard Hallberg-Rassy on the traditional boatbuilder's island of Orust. The Hallberg-Rassy 46 is a very seaworthy, safe bluewater cruiser for long distance sailing with small crew designed by Argentinian architect Germán Frers (Hallberg-Rassy house designer). The deep center cockpit with fixed windscreen and high coaming provides good protection and wide side decks allow safe movement on board even in harsh conditions. Lots of storage space in lockers, compartments, below bunks and sofas etc. Both heads compartments with separate shower. The Hallberg-Rassy 46 was built under supervision of Germanischer Lloyd (GL). Hallberg-Rassy 46 in 2 cabin layout with sea berth and large lockers on starboard in passage to the forward cabin. Well-kept owner's yacht, continuous technical maintenance and care, every year in indoor winter storage. Extensive specification including hydraulic furling systems for mainsail and headsail, upgraded electric winches, diesel generator, bow thruster, two diesel heating system etc. New sails (main sail, genoa and code-0) in 2019. A key feature of this yacht is the dark blue painted hull.

### Layout/Interior

- Owner's heads with separate shower and direct access from aft cabin
- Saloon with L-shaped sofa on folding saloon table to port and longitudinal sofa to starboard
- U-shaped galley to starboard aft
  - Gas stove (2 burners and oven)
  - Double sink
  - Electric cool box
  - Electric freezer
- Forward facing chart table and navigator's seat in passage to aft cabin on port side

- Large lockers in passage to aft cabin
- Forward cabin with V-shaped double berth
- Large lockers and sea berth in passage to forward cabin on starboard side
- Forward heads compartment to port with separate shower cabin
- Well finished, exclusive interior in mahogany
