Description

Luxurious decksaloon yacht built by the French quality shipyard Wauquiez International SAS. Designer: Berret/Racoupeau Yacht design. The Pilot Saloon 40 has a bright, friendly decksaloon with elevated saloon floor (360° panorama from dinette). Spacious owner's cabin aft over the entire beam of the yacht with large, double island berth and owner's heads with separate shower. Forward guest cabin with V-shaped double berth and second heads compartment. Lots of storage space in lockers, drawers and shelves. The Wauquiez Pilot Saloon 40 has a beautiful teak interior (floorboards in teak with maple strips). Well equipped and continuously maintained owner's yacht. Numerous investments in recent years (new bowthruster in 2015, underwater paint totally rebuilt in 2015, new sprayhood and cockpit cover in 2014, new chartplotter in 2015, new batteries in 2014, etc.).

Rigging/Sails

- Rigged with a deck stepped, 9/10 fractional SPARCRAFT mast with two sets of aftswept spreaders
- Second forestay with furler for selftacking solent jib
- Spinnaker pole (stowed on mast)
- HARKEN self-tacking rail on deck
- Sails: Fully battened mainsail INCIDENCES approx. 38,0 m² with lazy jacks and lazy bag
- Furling genoa INCIDENCES 140 % approx. 47,0 m² with UV-protection on FACNOR genoa furler
- Self tacking solent jib INCIDENCES approx. 22,0 m² with UV-protection on second forestay with FACNOR furler
- Spinnaker INCIDENCES with snuffer and spinnaker gear

Deck

- Teak on running decks, swimplatform and in cockpit
- Teak rubbing strake on hull
- Sprayhood with fixed windscreen and integrated LED cockpit lighting
- Cockpit cover

- Folding cockpit table
- Large folding swimplatform with free access to cockpit
- Dedicated storage space for liferaft behind swimplatform

- Longitudinal galley to port with Corian worktop
- Gas stove (2 flames and oven)

- Queensize island double berth and ensuite owner's heads with separate shower
- Forward guest cabin with V-shaped double berth and second heads compartment

- Lee board in forward double berth
