The Eagle 54 is designed in close cooperation with Hoek Design, one of the world's leading offices for naval architecture. No compromises were made on beauty and elegance: the Eagle 54 combines timeless classic lines with modern features and a contemporary underwater hull. Perfectly suited for daysailing or extended stays on board, she offers luxury, comfort, and sailing performance in equal measure.





Easy to handle

Perfectly balanced, yet so powerful

The Eagle 54 blends classic beauty with modern innovation. With a contemporary underwater profile, a lightweight carbon foam-core hull and deck and carefully selected deck hardware, positioned so that all key controls are within reach of the helmsman, the Eagle 54 is straightforward to sail, even single-handed.

We believe that sailing an Eagle should be uncomplicated and enjoyable. And with a displacement of just 9 tons, the Eagle 54 offers not only timeless elegance, but also a responsive and engaging sailing experience.

Ultra-sleek deck

Clean Lines, Effortless Control

With halyards and the jib sheets running below the deck to the steering position, the Eagle 54 has an ultra-sleek deck layout. For easy handling, the winches for both the jib- and gennaker sheets as well as the halyards are positioned within easy reach of the helmsman.

The halyard tails are neatly concealed within the cockpit coaming. A captive winch mounted below deck allows the mainsheet to be trimmed at the push of a button, while the powered headsail furler is also hidden below deck.

Well-equipped beauty

Needles to say, that with size comes both speed and comfort. The Eagle 54 offers enough space below deck to spend a longer stay on board. Above deck, a spacious cockpit allows family and friends to relax and enjoy the day on the water. A luxurious mahogany cockpit table adds the perfect touch, providing the ideal spot for a leisurely lunch or cold drinks during sunset hours.

For ultimate comfort, the Eagle 54 features a master cabin in the bow, a well-appointed galley with a refrigerator, sink, and electric cooking hobs, a spacious saloon with two sofas, each 2 meters long, and a mahogany table. A separate bathroom with shower and toilet completes the onboard amenities, making her the perfect luxury daysailer for long sunny days in secluded bays or extended weekend getaways.



Customizable interior

To suit your lifestyle

The Eagle 54 is a semi-custom yacht, allowing owners to tailor the interior to their personal taste. By default, it features bright white woodwork with matte varnished mahogany trims, but it can also be crafted entirely in mahogany or other high-quality woods, in matte or high-gloss finishes.

Every detail can be personalized, from upholstery and wood finishes to subtle design touches, making each Eagle 54 truly one-of-a-kind. This flexibility ensures that the yacht reflects your individual style.



From bow to stern

A detailed description

Describing the Eagle 54 from bow to stern, the flush deck is elegantly finished with Permateek decking. At the bow, the anchor locker is easily accessible, while a low footrail runs aft along the deck. The most forward section houses the anchor locker. The anchor is placed on a custom stainless steel anchor arm and is easily deployed and retrieved using the powered Lewmar windlass. When stowed, there is room for storing fenders. Just behind the anchor locker is the forepeak hatch, providing a dry storage space, while below the floor lies the retractable bow thruster. Two stainless steel bars are fitted for securing gennaker sheets and mooring lines.

The ultra-sleek deck is kept uncluttered, with all lines running neatly below deck. Stainless steel genoa tracks with precision cars guide the jib sheets back to the cockpit. The cabin roof, adorned with a mahogany varnished margin plank, features a large skylight, bathing the saloon in natural light.

The spacious cockpit offers comfortable seating for multiple guests. The helmsman enjoys a dedicated steering bench, perfect for single-handed sailing or sharing the experience with family and friends. The stainless steel steering wheel, with its mahogany rim, mounted on the steering pedestal, along with the stainless steel Ritchie Globe Master compass and the luxurious varnished mahogany table, provides a true sense of elegant luxury.

At the aft deck, a large lazarette with two flush hatches offers ample storage for fenders, a passerelle, swimming ladder and more.

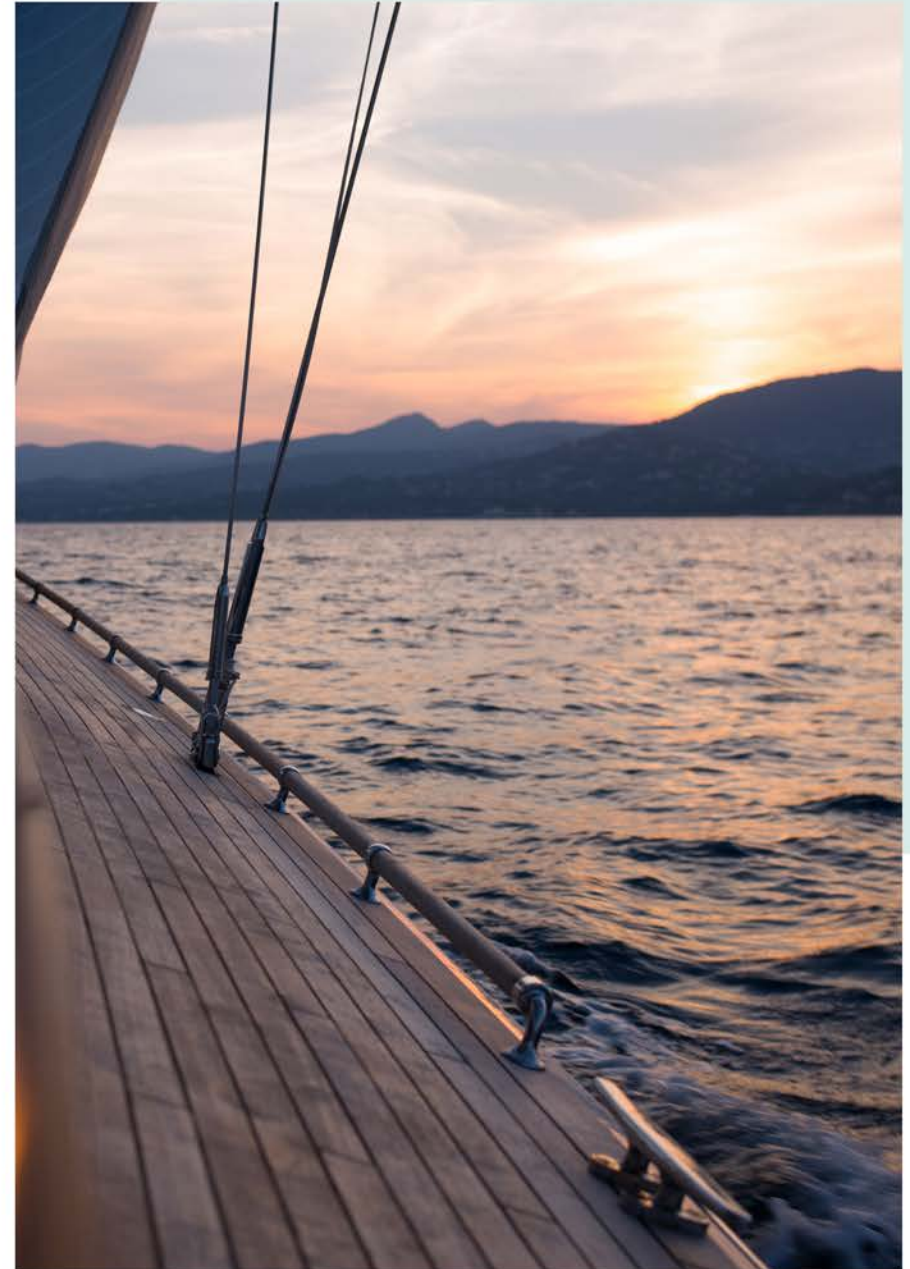




Construction

Timeless design, modern materials

- ≈ Carbon hull and deck
- ≈ Hull finished with spray paint in color of choice
- ≈ Superstructure finished with spray paint in Oyster white
- ≈ A recessed cove line
- ≈ Below the waterline epoxy primers and barrier coat finished with light grey or black antifouling
- ≈ Inside of hull / bilges painted white
- ≈ Permateek decking
- ≈ Cabin roof in Permateek with a varnished mahogany margin plank
- ≈ High performance T-bulb fin keel
- ≈ Stainless steel construction with lead bulb
- ≈ Glass sliding cabin entrance hatch with skylight extending forward
- ≈ Forward skylight hatch with mahogany finish
- ≈ Flush anchor locker hatch with gas spring

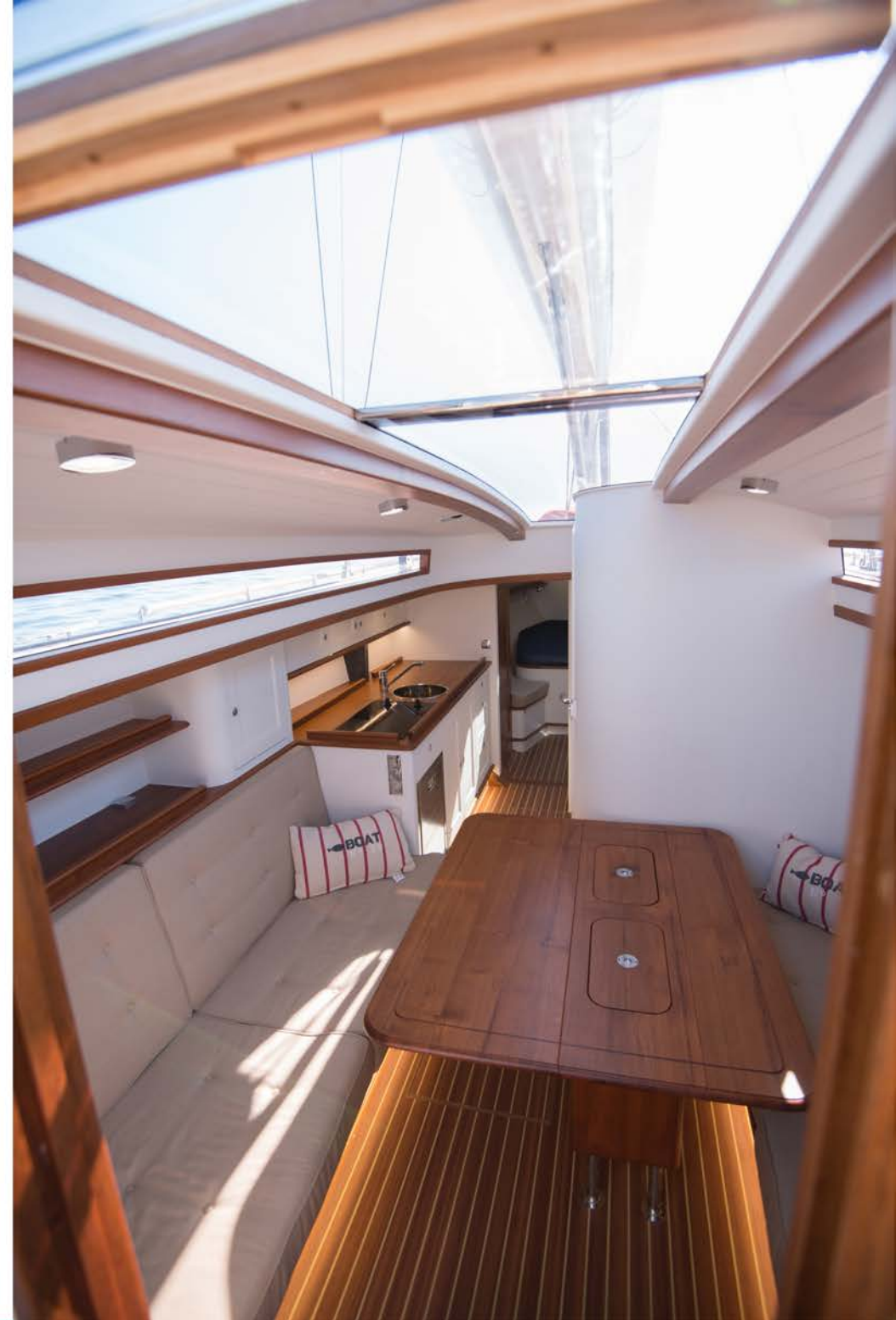
